



Prospect Summer Activities Program -2011

The Prospect Summer Activities Program located at Long River Middle School is designed to give kids fun while taking part in activities during the summer. A pizza and ice cream party will be held at the end of each session, parents and guardians are welcome to attend. Special activities are planned for each session and for the safety of our children, there will be an EMT or an MRT on the premises at all times.

Children may pick from a variety of classes and will attend those classes each day. Snacks will be provided and will be given around 10:30 AM. There will be five classes daily for a two week period. Children are placed in groups according to their entering grade. Children must be entering grades Kindergarten through 8th grade in the upcoming September school year.

Students will pick their top 5 choices for each week. See back of this letter for class descriptions. Completed Schedules will be mailed in June.

Students entering Grades 7th – 8th can be a Counselor in Training (CIT). This program is designed so the student can experience a sense of leadership within a group setting. The CIT's will assist teachers in lower grades Monday through Friday from 8:30 – 12:30. CIT's will be placed in the classes where assistance is needed. (A discounted rate of \$35.00 for students in the CIT program) If not interested in being a CIT, Seventh and Eighth Graders – can also attend the program and NOT be a CIT.

Program dates: Monday – Friday 8:30 – 12:30

Week One: July 5th – July 8th

Week Three: July 18th – July 23rd

Week Two: July 11th – July 15th

Week Four: July 25th – July 29th

Program Fee:

- \$50.00 per child per week. Children may choose to attend any of the four weeks. \$35.00 per CIT per week.

Class Descriptions

1. **NEW: All about Cars** – Campers **START YOUR ENGINES!** – Campers will design cars, build cars, play games with the cars they made and then....they will enjoy racing them. Who will cross the finish line first?

Grades 4th and up: Games, arts and crafts, celebrations, baking/cooking dance, stories and sports.
3. **Arts and Crafts: MAKE IT AND TAKE IT.** Staying **GREEN...** Campers will use things from around the house (supplies by the camp) to make something new.
4. **NEW BUILDING WITH BOXES:**

5. **Computers: Grades 2nd – 6th.** Share and swap your game sites with classmates. Play games while exploring the computer world.

7. **Hoops** -Activities Both indoor & outdoor, related to Basketball
8. **Games and Puzzles and Lego's:** Simple activities that emphasis patience, sportsmanship and problem solving skills.
9. **Kid in the Kitchen:** Come and have a tasty treat.... one we're sure you'll love to eat.... Pretzels, pizza, cupcakes too... one for me and one for you!
